#### 11. Whether the objectives were achieved (Give details): Yes.

The main objectives of the project cited above were achieved at the end of the study. To begin with, the study of American novels about Iraq war offered an opportunity to the investigator to interpret and reinterpret all major novels that came out of the Iraq war. It also brought to the notice of the investigator that there has been tremendous change in which the war has been fought. Every war prior to this has been differently fought both in mind and on ground. The use of technology has moulded the genre of war fiction and it requires a great deal of study of new inventions in warfare weapons on the part of the investigator making his/ her job challenging and multidimensional. Secondly, the study naturally compelled the investigator to make comparisons in novels selected with its authors with regard to theme, style and technique of narration. The two female writers than three male writers, for example, in the selected study are more sensible and concerned about familial bond which a woman soldier always stories for. Of the five novelists selected for study two writers namely, Kevin Powers and David Abrams of whom Powers being the Iraq war veteran and Abrams being war journalist bear the ground experience of war and that makes them distinct war writers in their narrative mode. Naturally, their war narrative exhibits war as if it is a running commentary of the ongoing Iraq war. Despite America's claim of its victory in Vietnam and Iraq it has been said time and again that America lost the Vietnam War whereas its victory in Iraq is doubtful.

#### 12. Achievements from the Report:

The research project undertaken entitled *Isolation and survival problems* of soldiers in select American novels about Iraq war has once again revealed to the world that despite technological inventions in war fare activities and ultra modern techniques in unveiling the secrecy about bio chemical weapons of war, we are unable to bring an end to any war – big or small on planet earth. On the contrary, growing number of wars are only leading to another war in future. Secondly, Iraq war like the Vietnam War seemed to be resulted in total failure except the success of overthrowing the tyrannical regime of Saddam

Hossain. The American army as it were continued to exploit the female soldiers during the war. The novels selected for study under Minor Research Project have resulted in following findings:

- 1. War novels in general and American novels about Iraq war in particular showcase the intolerable suffering of soldiers caused due to war
- 2. When compared to previous American war novels, the Iraq war novels are written with more pro citizen perspective in Iraqi and American society.
- 3. The Iraq war novels show the failure of the U.S. administrative policy as its charge on Saddam Hussain regarding secret storage of Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD) in Iraq resulted in nothing but waged war on Iraq and its people.
- 4. With regard to life of the Iraqis, the war brought no change in their life. That is to say, to them the life before and after Saddam's regime remained the same for the American army also exploited and tortured them.
- 5. Despite the U.S. claims of its win in Iraq war, it proved time and again that it was far from truth.
